2. Application requirements

- Applicants with the aspirations of studying in higher education institutions in Japan like universities, postgraduate programs or professional training colleges. (Preparation course, Postgraduate course)
 - Those who have completed 12 years of formal schooling in their home countries (6 years of primary school, 3 years of middle school, 3 years of high school. In case of China equivalent of Japan high school.) and meet all requirements to enter higher education institute.
 - ※ In cases when student has not completed 12 years of education in their home country or, in case of China, completed vocational high school or vocational school please contact us individually.
 - Those who have studied Japanese for more than 150 hours. (Those who are above the level of Japanese Language Proficiency Test N4) : 1,5 year preparation course
Those who have studied Japanese for more than 550 hours. (Those who are above the level of Japanese Language Proficiency Test N2, N3) : 1 year preparation course
 - Those who including family and relatives do not have criminal record in Japan.
 - Those who in last 2 years have not been in Japan for training purpose.
Must have cleared all 1 – 4 requirements.
- Applicants not pursuing further education in Japan at universities, postgraduate programs or professional training colleges. (General course)
 - Those who have studied Japanese for more than 150 hours. (Those who are above the level of Japanese Language Proficiency Test N4.)
 - Those who including family and relatives do not have criminal record in Japan.
 - Those who in last 2 years have not been in Japan for training purpose.
Must have cleared all 1 – 3 requirements.

3. How to apply

Students who wants to enter first must take screening examination.

1. Enrolment examination process

Those who want to apply please fill in “Application Form” and send it to school by fax or post. Upon receiving school will inform you about place and day of examination. Please bring with you examination fee in Japanese yen by the time of examination.

2. Application deadline

January Admissions	Each year from May to September 20 th
April Admissions	Each year from August to December 20 th
July Admissions	Each year from November to March 20 th
October Admissions	Each year from February to June 20 th

3. Subject of examination

Postgraduate・Preparation 2 year・Preparation 1,5 year courses:Japanese, essay (native language) , interview
General course:Japanese, interview

4. Submit application documents (After passing screening examination)

After passing screening examination please send us rest of the documents. In case of not sending documents by the deadline we can cancel your application, so please be careful. (For details please refer to school site download section documents.)

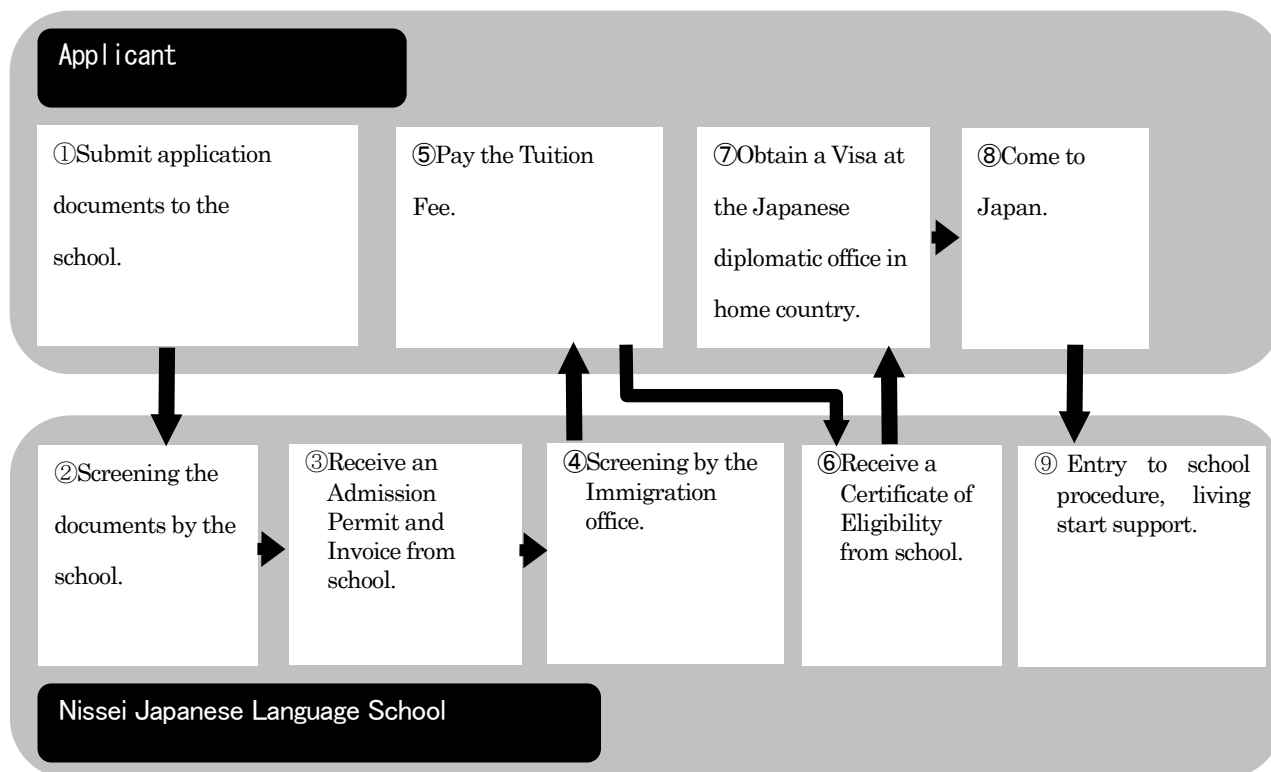
